Perathoner (cov)

Redlum[®] is a red strain of Gala (Kids orange x Golden).



Fruit

- **Maturity** : Middle of August, Golden -20 days.
- **Colour** : Very intense lightly striped, coloration on 99% of the fruit. The number of stripes increases with the age of the trees. High out-pack.
- **Presentation / Form** : High shaped, regular form, attractive, not sensible for russet.
- **Size** : Regular, average size 70/80.
- **Taste** : Sweet, 13° - 14°Brix, Juicy and crispy .
- **Flesh** : Crispy.
- **Harvest** : One or two picking rounds, not sensible for pré harvest drop of.
- **Conservation** : In normal storage 3 to 4 months, in CA until March.
- **Diseases** : Like standard Gala, sensible for apple-scab.

Tree

- **Vigour** : Moderated, the tree is easy to handle.
- **Productivity** : High yields are possible. Thinning must be done; Redlum[®] is moderated sensible for biennial bearing. The tree is sensible for European Cancer (*nectria galigena*).

Flowering

- **Flowering period** : Like Golden, high flowering capacity, strong thinning is necessary to avoid biannual bearing.
- **Pollinators** : Golden, Granny, grap apple,...
